Candidates for offices subject to the State Government Ethics Act must file their Statement of Economic Interest (“SEI”) in the same place and in the same manner as their notice of candidacy according to G.S. 163-106.

The State Government Ethics Act requires that candidates for certain offices file a Statement of Economic Interest (“SEI”) no later than March 12, 2012, for the current candidate cycle. However, if you are already a “covered person” and there have been no changes to your responses to the questions on your 2011 SEI, the completion of this No-Change Form will satisfy your filing requirement.

North Carolina law establishes a fine of \$250 for failure to timely comply with the annual SEI filing requirement. In addition, it is a Class 1 misdemeanor to knowingly conceal or fail to disclose required information. It is a Class H felony to provide false information on a Statement of Economic Interest. Such actions can also subject you to disciplinary action in connection with your employment.

§ 138A-26. Concealing or failing to disclose material information.

A filing person who knowingly conceals or knowingly fails to disclose information that is required to be disclosed on a statement of economic interest under this Article shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor and shall be subject to disciplinary action under G.S. 138A-45. (2006-201, s. 1.)

§ 138A-27. Penalty for false information.

A filing person who provides false information on a statement of economic interest as required under this Article knowing that the information is false is guilty of a Class H felony and shall be subject to disciplinary action under G.S. 138A-45. (2006-201, s. 1.)
